### Sibling Concessions

A concession of 20% is applied to tuition fees for the second enrolled student from the same household. Sibling enrolments are subject to available placement and the standard enrolment process.

### Payment of Accounts

**Tuition fees are invoiced per term and are due by the end of the first week of each term.**

Families may elect to pay fees via one of the following methods:

1. Termly instalment — four equal payments of \$5,562 per term (eldest student).
2. Annual upfront — full annual fee of \$22,250 due by the end of Week 1, Term 1. (Attracts 10% discount)
3. Monthly payment plan — 10 equal monthly instalments of \$2,225.00 (eldest student), payable February to November. Contact the school office to arrange a payment plan agreement.

## Supplementary Information

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**Fees exclude:** uniforms that the students will need to purchase depending on the season.

**Withdrawal Notice:** One full term's written notice to the principal is required when withdrawing a student from the school. An assessment of loss up to one term's fees may be charged where insufficient notice is provided, in accordance with the Enrolment Contract.
